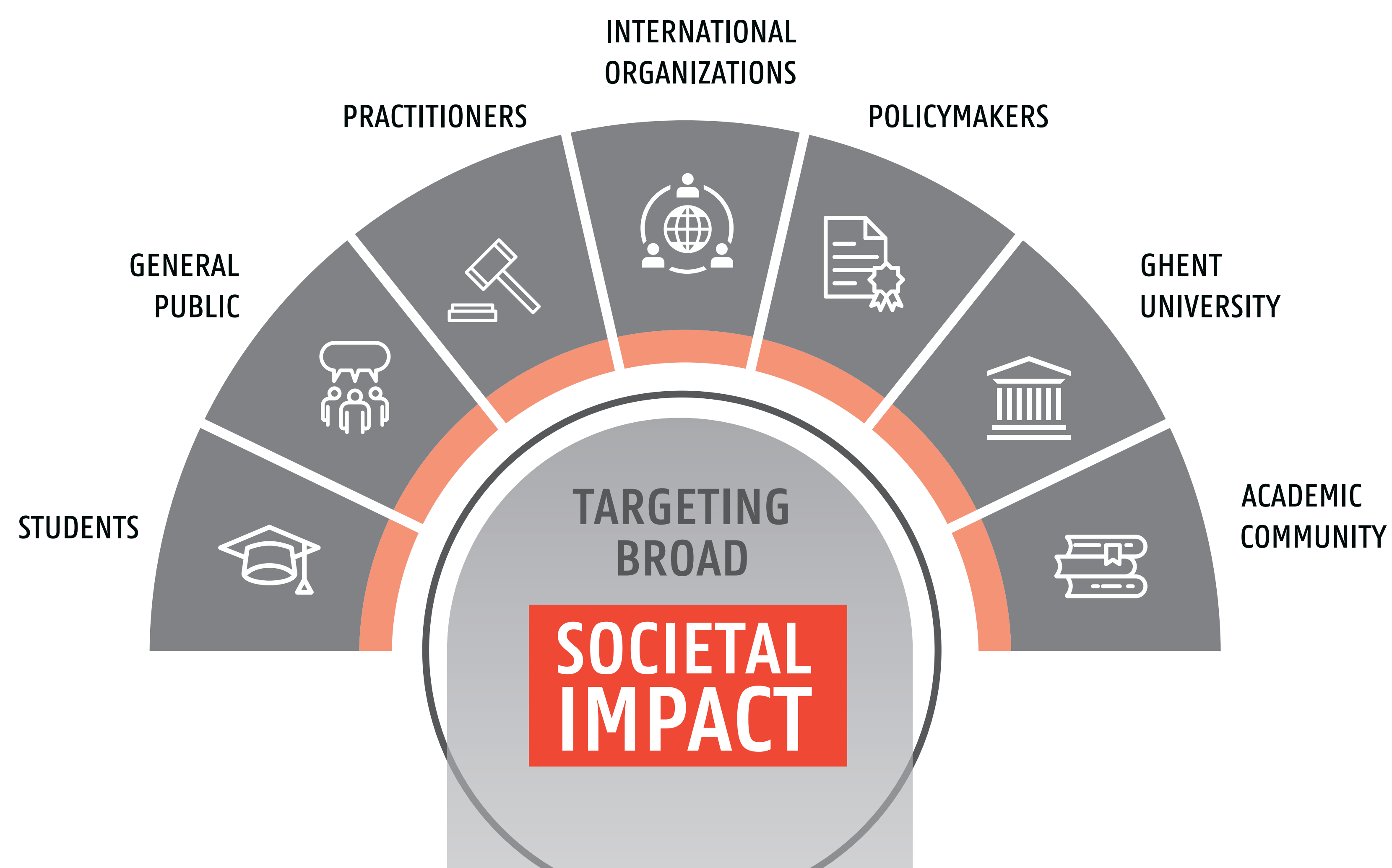


IDC Crime, Criminology & Criminal Policy
